### **LAST WEEK ATTENDANCE STATISTIC** – Sunday, July 5 – 29.

<u>PARISH NEWS</u> - Information on the lighting work that Mr. Michael Russell, his son Michael, and Mr. Joseph Petrusky, performed for the church on last Sunday, July 5. They were able to remove eleven flood lights that shone on the altar and replaced them with energy efficient LED flood lights. These LED lights are 80% more efficient than the previous halogen flood lights. These bulbs will not only cost less to operate, but they will also last a lot longer (approximately 22 years). Due to the upfront expense of purchasing these LED lights (\$323.07), the Russells family wanted to help out by paying \$100.00 towards the cost of the bulbs. Thank you very much!
