JULY – ST. PAUL: EARLY LIFE AND TRANSFORMATION.

Reflection and Action item: St. Paul readily admits that he has “a past.” But we all do, don’t we? With him, though, we are called by Jesus to turn our backs to our sinfulness and our faces toward Him that we might live in holiness and righteousness and, in doing so, lead others to Him as well. This will not always be easy for us, just as it often a struggle for the Apostle. Yet, the love of Jesus compels us to keep trying. Each week this month, make some personal or family sacrifice (*example: fasting from a meal, abstaining from a favorite food or recreational activity, etc.*) that those who have not yet come to know Jesus as their Lord may come to see and embrace the salvation and peace that He alone offers.
