Jesus came into the world and turned it upside down. He is the Son of God but teaches us that He is also the servant of all.

I Reading: Isaiah 53:10-11 II Reading: Hebrews 4:14-16 GOSPEL: Mark 10:35-45

James and John, the sons of Zebedee, approached Jesus. 'Master,' they said to him 'we want you to do us a favor.' He said to them, 'What is it you want me to do for you?' They said to him, 'Allow us to sit one at your right hand and the other at your left in your glory.' 'You do not know what you are asking' Jesus said to them.
