Next Sunday, June 5: Solemnity of Pentecost – Clergy Appreciation

Today's readings convey a clear, if uncomfortable, message about the Church as the body of Christ. Since the beginning people have tried to impose rules and controls on who is an insider and who an outsider, who belongs and who is excluded. Jesus' own teaching is very clear. It is the Holy Spirit who judges and guides not only the leaders but all the faithful. Our attempts at exclusion and control are according to "the world", not the Spirit.

I Reading: Acts 7:55-60

II Reading: Revelation 22:12-14,16-17,20

GOSPEL: John 17:20-26

Jesus raised His eyes to heaven and said: "I pray not only for my disciples, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, so that they may all be one, as you, Father, are in me and I in you, that they also may be in us, that the world may believe that You sent Me. And I have given them the glory You gave Me, so that they may be one, as we are one, I in them and You in Me, that they may be brought to perfection as one, that the world may know that You sent Me, and that You love them even as You loved Me. Father, they are Your gift to me. I wish that where I am they also may be with Me, that they may see my glory that You gave Me, because You loved Ye before the foundation of the world. Righteous Father, the world also does not know You, but I know You, and they know that You sent Me. I have made known to them Your name and I will make it known, that the love with which You loved Me may be in them and I in them."

JUNE – THE SOLEMNITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI

Reflection and Action item: On Thursday after the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, the Catholic Churches around the world celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi. This Solemnity is a religious manifestation and confession of Christian and Catholic faith. On that day, after celebrating the Eucharist the faithful go in a solemn procession with the Blessed Sacrament to four altars. The Solemnity of Corpus Christi has been solemnly celebrated in parishes of the PNCC since her organization. It was adopted from Western Catholic tradition and is strongly connected with our faith in the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. Processions held within the octave are often combined parish and/or seniorate celebrations. **Action item:** Attending the parish or Seniorate Corpus Christi Service giving thanks and praise to God for His precious gift of the presence of our Lord in the Holy Eucharist.
