JUNE - THE SOLEMNITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI

Reflection and Action item: On Thursday after the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, the Catholic Churches around the world celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi. This Solemnity is a religious manifestation and confession of Christian and Catholic faith. On that day, after celebrating the Eucharist the faithful go in a solemn procession with the Blessed Sacrament to four altars. The Solemnity of Corpus Christi has been solemnly celebrated in parishes of the PNCC since her organization. It was adopted from Western Catholic tradition and is strongly connected with our faith in the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. Processions held within the octave are often combined parish and/or seniorate celebrations. Action item: Attending the parish or Seniorate Corpus Christi Service giving thanks and praise to God for His precious gift of the presence of our Lord in the Holy Eucharist.
