WORLD	insurance or not. It was the recommendation of the engineer to use either modified rock or flowable
	fill to fill this hole in.
	If we use the modified rock to fill it in there will need to be further restoration.
	Pavements will need to be replaced as well as shrubs and fencing. This can be quite expensive.
	To fill this hole it is going to take $3 - 4$ triaxles of rock or $2 - 3$ cement trucks of flowable fill.
	The flowable fill can't be poured all at once. It has to be poured over a period of time.
	This problem needs to be handled whether we get insurance money or not.
	More could cave in, someone could get hurt, or the rectory could be damaged if we don't correct this.
	Please keep your parish in your prayers. We will keep you updated on this development.
